When children start pre-school, they will need to dress/undress themselves to a certain extent. Any opportunity to show this level of dexterity is looked upon favourably.







Children may not be asked to use cutlery at the assessment, but school's will be looking for skills that show their ability to do so.



Children may be asked to put their coat on to go outside. Any independence and confidence in dressing/undressing is a positive. Children will be expected to vocalise any toileting needs during the assessment.
